The Community

Fuquay-Varina is located in Southern Wake County, approximately 20 miles south of Raleigh, North Carolina. The Wake County Public School System is the largest district in the state, with a student population of nearly 160,000 across 31 high schools. Fuquay-Varina is one of North Carolina's fastest growing communities and is home to over 43,000 residents who are economically and ethnically diverse.

The School

Fuquay-Varina High School is a comprehensive 4-year high school enrolling over 1,700 students in grades 9 through 12. The school day is organized on a 4 by 4 block schedule. Our high school has gained accreditation from the North Carolina State Board of Education and AdvanceEd. FVHS "Exceeded Growth" according to the North Carolina Department of Public Instruction and students continue to meet or exceed Growth Standards across subjects. FVHS students are taught by highly qualified teachers.

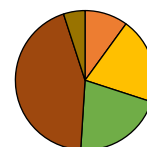
